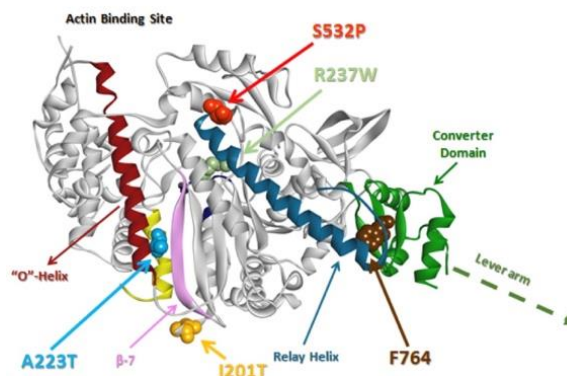

**Registration** – The registration opens on October 1<sup>st</sup>, deadline will be Wednesday December 19<sup>th</sup>. Please find the registration form on our homepage (<http://alpbach-motors.cryoem-hd.de> – which will go online October 1<sup>st</sup>). The form must be fully completed, a confirmation of registration will be sent to you.

**Abstracts titles** are requested for registration, full abstracts will be required by mid-February and will be used to allocate the oral sessions.

**Costs** – Unfortunately costs for the Congress Centrum and bus transfer have slightly increased since the last conference three years ago. The new registration fee is €210 plus bus transfer. In order to simplify the bank transfers and reduce the bank charges you can use our PayPal Account (for more information see web page and our 3<sup>rd</sup> Circular later this year).

**Bus transfer** – As in the years before we will provide a bus service from Munich airport or main train station to Alpbach. Attendees who want to use the bus transfer will pay 30€/pp per single journey. 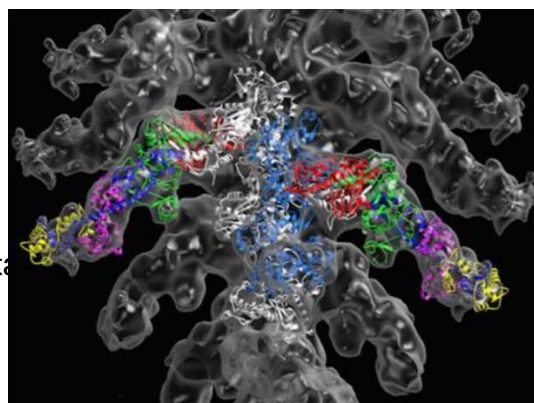

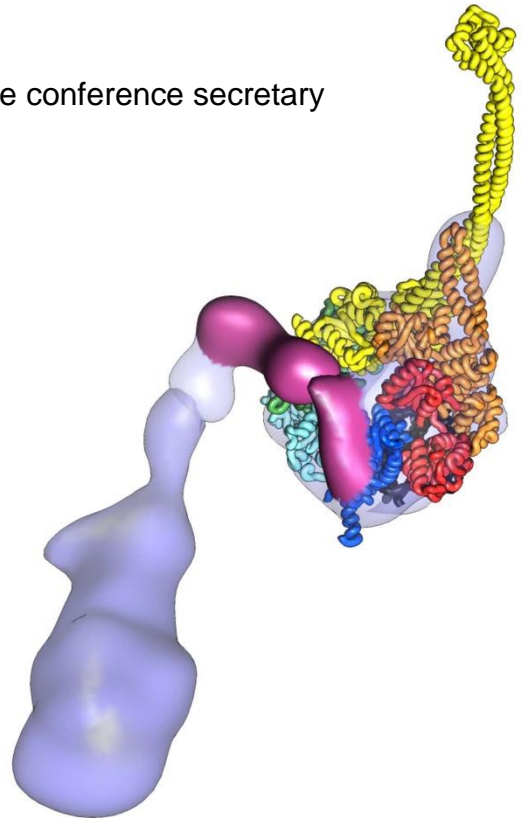
Prices are full-board, Saturday (evening) to Friday (morning)

Possible session titles and the person responsible for the session organisation

- Theory & Modelling motor action
- Motor linked disease & drugs
- Static and dynamic cytoskeleton
- Forces in vivo and in artificial systems

Note that we plan to appoint 2 co-chairs for each session. Volunteers for chairs and suggestions for other session tiles are very welcome.

### Alpbach rules

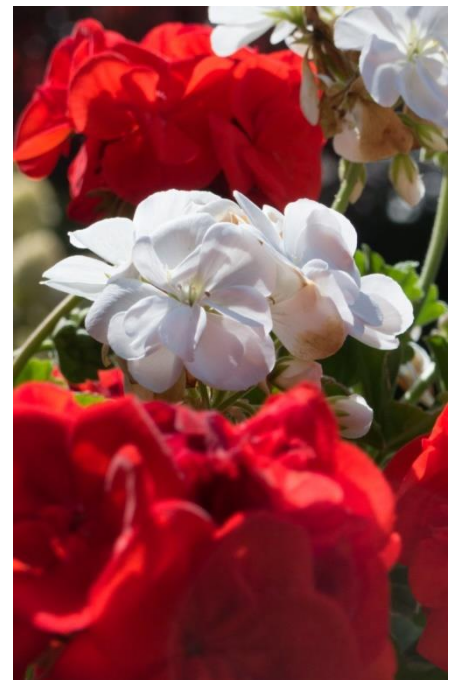
All participants are expected to provide an abstract and a poster, which contains the experimental details. We hope that all posters will be on display for the entire week

As many participants as possible will be given the opportunity to make a short oral presentation at the discretion of the session chairs. The selected speakers should emphasise the novelty & significance of the work to provoke discussion - with details provided on the poster

In response to comments from the last meeting two formal poster session will take place this time. This inevitably means fewer oral presentations.

To compensate for fewer talks we request the session chairs (or co-chair) to hold a short poster highlight section of their session and note any contrasts or controversies in the data/interpretation.

We will also make more use of afternoon breakout session for discussion of specific focused topics. Request for such session can be submitted at any time up to and during the meeting.

We are able to support 15 young investigators. This will be in the form of registration wavers (210€) and contributions towards hotel costs (340€).

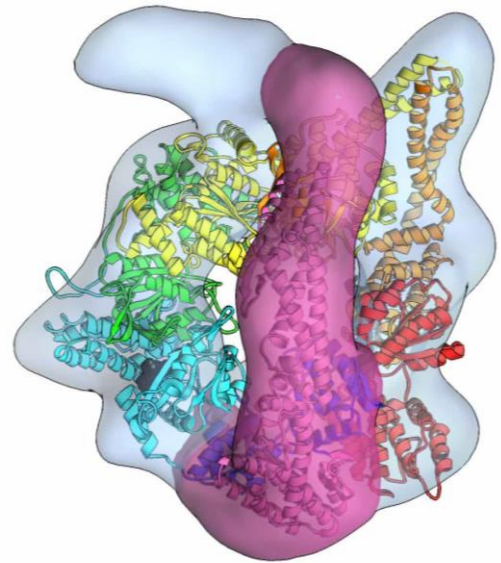
To be eligible, registrants should

Be a graduate student or within 3 years of graduation,

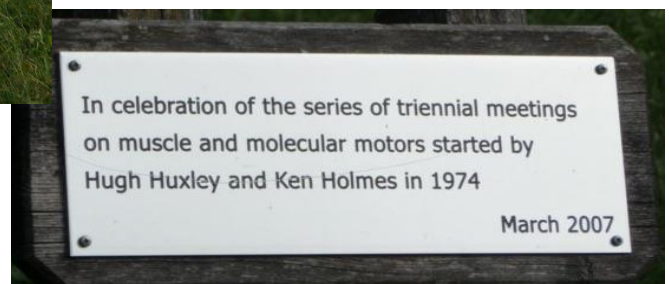
Submit an abstract to the meeting,
